SUBJECT: Nellis and Creech Air Force Base Dining Facility Utilization Authorization

1. This letter provides guidance on authorization to eat in the base dining facilities in accordance with AFI 34-239, *Food Service Management Program*. The following personnel are authorized to use the dining facilities based on the installation commander's determination that the dining facilities have adequate capacity and service will not have an impact on the service provided for Essential Station Messing (ESM) and TDY travelers to Nellis Air Force Base and Creech Air Force Base who are receiving the meal portion of per diem.

- a. Officers, active duty family members, military retirees and their immediate family members are permitted to eat in the dining facilities on federal holidays, Easter and the Air Force Birthday.
- b. Military (officers and enlisted) and DoD civilians who are TDY and receiving the meal portion of per diem are authorized to eat at the dining facilities when it is authorized on their TDY orders.
- c. Officers and DoD civilians on alert status requiring immediate availability or when required to eat as a group (such as fire fighters and security forces) in the dining facilities.
- d. Commanders and their designated representatives are permitted to eat in the dining facility for purposes of determining the quantity and quality of food served.
- e. Members and chaperones of organized non-profit youth groups when extended the privilege of visiting a base are permitted to eat in the dining facilities.
- f. Spouses of deployed members are permitted to eat in the dining facilities on a limited basis as determined by the installation commander.
- g. Guests and immediate family members of ESM members are permitted to eat in the dining facilities during regular dinner meals on weekdays or at any meal on weekends, federal holidays, Easter and the Air Force Birthday. As specified in AFI 34-239, the ESM member must accompany guests and family members.
- h. Total Force military and civilians of all ranks are authorized to use the Creech AFB dining facility.
