Transition GPS 5-day Seminar

This seminar is *congressionally mandated* for *ALL* members. This five day program is designed to prepare military members and family members for their transitional journey from military to civilian life in the workforce. Retirees can participate as many as 24 months prior to their retirement date. Separates must attend during the last 12 months of service from their DOS.

Pre-Separation Briefing

This is a *Mandatory* briefing for *ALL* separates within 12 months prior to DOS and retirees within 24 months of their retirement date. Learn about all the resources and agencies that can help you during your transition back to civilian life and the workforce. Spouses are welcome to attend.

Capstone

This workshop is to complete transitioning VOW compliance requirements. Members must bring all deliverables discussed during the pre-separation briefing, repeated during the transition seminar and sent via email correspondence. Members must know the Commander or designees (typically First Sergeants) identification information for email correspondence. At a minimum, the name and squadron if listed on the global network.

Remote Control

Receive information for you and our family as you prepare for your remote or unaccompanied tour. Spouses are welcome to attend.

Accessing Higher Education Track

This course is designed to guide you through the variety of decisions involved in choosing a degree completion program, preparing for the college admissions process, and finding funding.

Right Start

An introduction to Nellis AFB and the Greater Las Vegas Area. Mandatory for all new arrivals; spouses/significant others highly encourage to attend! Held at The Desert Oasis Club, Bldg 324.

Heart Link

AF 101 for military spouses. Event targets new military spouses. Connecting to self, others, resources and Leadership.

Professional Resume Writing

Resume writing formats, dos and don'ts of resume writing. Interviewing techniques, cover letters and resources/websites pertaining to job search/resume preparation.

How to Apply for Federal Jobs

"Real-time" navigation of USAJobs website, building an account, creating/updating profile, saving job searches, building targeted resumes, interpreting announcements and applying for positions.

Spouse Employment Workshop

Provide military spouses the opportunity to navigate through hiring initiatives such as SECO, MyCAA, Military OneSource, and Military Spouse Hiring Preferences for Federal Employment.

Pre-Deployment/Education Briefing

Pre-deployment briefings are conducted at Bldg 811. Members will receive information and be signed off their checklist at this time.

Welcome Home

Returning deployers are required to attend within 72 hrs of returning. Spouses encouraged to attend. Located in the Base Chapel basement.

First Duty Station Officer

Meets AFI requirements for all First Duty Station Officers. Includes TSP, Credit, and basic budgeting.

PCS out of Nellis AFB? Finance, Legal, EMP, EFMP, Vet Office, TMO, Housing and more all come together to help make this a smooth transition. Spouses/Significant others are highly encouraged to attend.

Deployed/Remote Family Dinners

Basic Investing 101:

Education and information on the basics of investing. Participants will learn about the different investing options to include TSP, IRS's, mutual funds, stocks, bonds, etc; as well as be informed on the varies basic investing educational resources.
